Ray C. Janeway Scholarship: \$2,000

TLA Summer School Scholarship: \$500

While applicants may be enrolled year round, the scholarship applies only to the summer session.

Van Dusen-Tobin-Kaiser Scholarship: \$1,000 (Awarded in even number years only.)

For applicants pursuing graduate studies leading to a career as an elementary school or children's librarian.

Vivian Greenfield Education Award: \$1,500

Provides funding for an educational endeavor reinforcing work with youth: can include professional development activities (taking a course or attending a conference), implementing a new idea in the workplace, performing a study, and more.

Walter H. Escue Memorial Scholarship: \$1,000

For applicants concentrating studies in technical services, systems administration, or library automation.

DEMCO, Inc. / TLA Research Grant: Up to \$2000

Available to help underwrite the costs of a research project. Qualitative and quantitative studies related to library issues will be funded. Pilot projects and experimental programs involving several libraries are encouraged.

Escue Annual Conference Stipend: \$250

Available for a paraprofessional living or working in Texas to defray the costs of the TLA Annual Conference. An application must be submitted online no later than **December 18**.
