









2022-2023 Texas Bluebonnet Award

You do not need to mail the hard copy ballots as a backup.

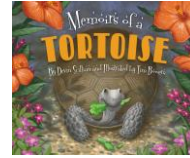

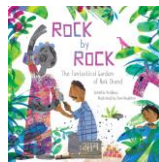

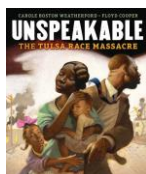
